Theme of workshop: "Alla-Prima Landscapes in Soft Pastel"

Stressed will be the four basics of any painting: Shape, Value, Color, and Edges. We will produce "painterly" landscapes with the emphasis on trees, meadows, skies, and color in shadows. We will try to avoid photographic realism. Drawing skills and previous painting experience are a plus. Stressed will be stroke methods, touch, underpainting as a part of the finished work, various types of painting surfaces, negative shapes, color layering dark to light, color values, and simultaneous contrast. We will work from the student's photos or instructor's with emphasis on using the photo as a reference only, not copying verbatim. Underlying abstract composition will be demonstrated from a notan sketch. Expect plenty of personal attention and instruction at your easel. Each student will leave the class with a finished, frameable painting.

Supply list: Minimum 48 color Nu-Pastel assortment, 2- 9x12 sanded paper (UArt 400 preferred), Neutral color backing board 11x14 or larger, masking tape (prefer neutral or black), brush, small container, rubbing alcohol, pencil and paper to take notes, optional: small easel, aluminum foil
Instructor will provide a broad assortment of pastels from his personal stock in various brands and hardness for students to augment their own personal supply during class. "Try before you buy."
